The Flagship Group reduce energy bills for residents

The Flagship Group and Kensa Heat Pumps have worked together to install a micro district ground source heat network on an estate in Fressingfield built in 2010, comprising flats, bungalows, semi-detached and detached houses. These homes were experiencing high running costs and Flagship and its residents needed a sustainable long-term solution. This challenging project, involving five different heat networks for four distinct property types, was delivered in only nine weeks and has resulted in running cost savings of up to 50% while delivering income for Flagship via ECO and the RHI. This project clearly demonstrates that ground source heat pumps have the potential to change the future of heat production in social housing.

Judges' comment

We clearly need to find alternative ways of providing heat and hot water for our homes, and this looks like a very scalable approach.
